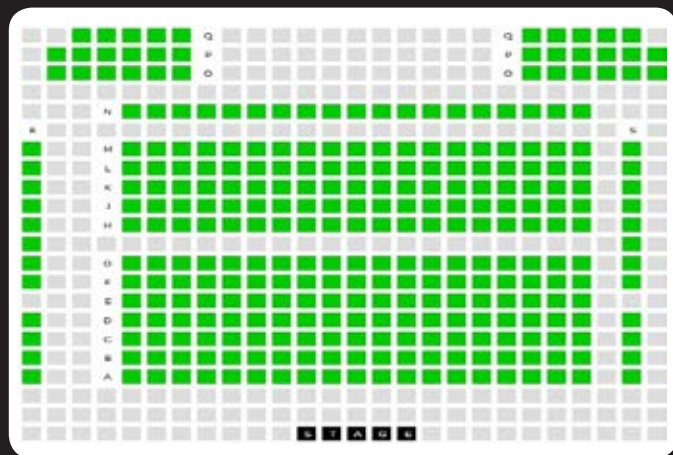

When illness strikes, friendship develops between the two women. Directed by Umat Dag, this film has captivated audiences on the international film festival circuit.

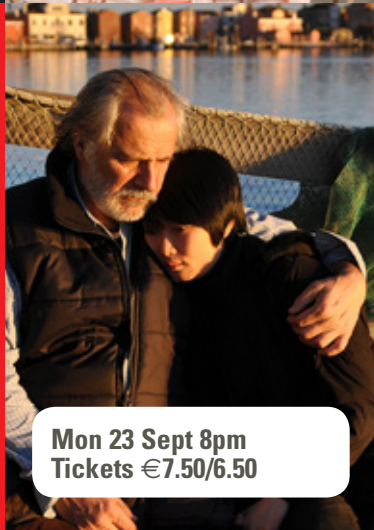
