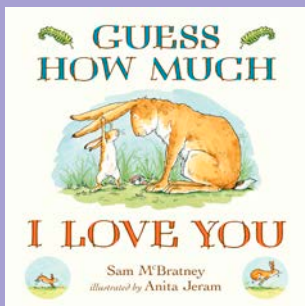

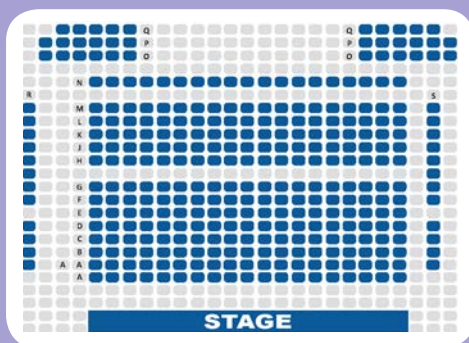
Parking Options
