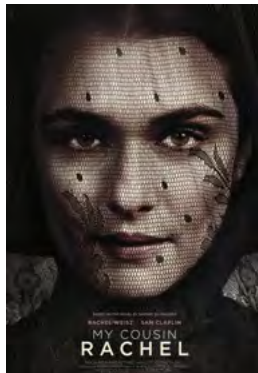
MY COUSIN RACHEL
