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Relaxed Performances at Pavilion Theatre

Relaxed Performances are open to everyone to attend, but they have been specifically designed to welcome people who will benefit from a more relaxed and flexible performance environment, including people with an Autism Spectrum Condition, sensory and communication disorders, a learning disability or a hidden disability.

While the quality and content of the show remain the same, the following adjustments might be made for a relaxed performance:

- House lights raised during the show (50%-75%) to reduce the darkness of the auditorium
- Audio levels reduced to remove any loud bangs or sound effects
- Strobe or flashing lights removed
- Audience members can walk in and out more freely during a relaxed performance
- A relaxed approach to noise and vocalisations in the auditorium during the show
- Designated quiet area to help reduce stress levels. This can be accessed at any stage of your visit, pre-show, during the show or post-show; ask a Pavilion representative if you are unsure where to go
- Staff and cast will have been briefed in advance to support and assist where possible
- The volume of announcements and music in the foyer will be reduced
